Through a combination of organic growth, acquisition, and strategic alliance, he helped to establish iFire as a leading candidate for the consumer flat panel television market.

Prior to that, he led a US\$100 million division of Unaxis, a leading manufacturer and provider of systems, components, and services to the flat panel display, semiconductor, medical, and defense industries. In this capacity he was responsible for global operations in 20 countries. As the Operations Manager for General Electric, he helped grow a new business from start-up to US\$200 million.

Mr. Goldstein's education includes a Bachelors degree in Engineering from the University of Southern Illinois and an MBA from the Wharton School. Dr. Pryor currently serves on the editorial board of the *American Journal of Medical Quality*. He has authored more than 250 publications and has been the principal investigator of a number of significant research investigations. In addition to his position at Ascension Health, Dr. Pryor currently holds several academic appointments including Consulting Associate Professor of Medicine at Duke University Medical Center and Adjunct Professor at St. Louis University School of Public Health.

Dr. Pryor is a graduate of the University of Michigan Medical School in Ann Arbor, Mich., and he completed his medical internship and residency at Pennsylvania Hospital in Philadelphia, and his fellowship in cardiovascular diseases at Duke University in Durham, North Carolina.
